

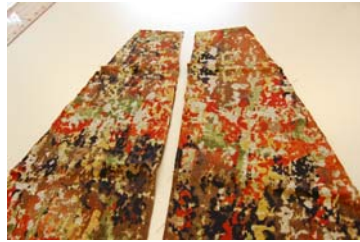

## **Travel Trio Three #226 Pocket Skirt**

This polyester spandex fabric gives you tons of options for colors to wear with it. Here I paired it with gray, orange and brown. They all work well to compliment the color scheme of the skirt.

Step 3 is very important to the overall appearance of the finished garment. Take your time and make sure that all of the layers in the pocket are laying flat. I worked from the bottom of the pocket and worked my way to the top seam that connects the facing to the lower front. I found it easier to rid the pocket of any fabric bunching that might occur and be visible through to the surface this way. After basting the layers together I placed the left and right front next to each other to see if the pocket placement of each panel were mirroring the other. It's much easier to fix any inconsistencies at this point than after you have already serged the seams.



If you want the pocket detail to be more obvious just use a solid color or use a different color for the upper front piece to color block the skirt.
